Tickets will be limited to 2 per family to start, and then at the end of the week on Friday after school (3:00), any leftover tickets will be released and you can book as many as you need on a first come first served basis. Again, tickets are limited to 2 per family to start, then any extra tickets will be released on December 1<sup>st</sup> after school and free to book on schoolcashonline on a first come first serve basis. Please do not select both the afternoon and evening show at first as we would like to give everyone a chance to attend. When all tickets are booked up, the event will be considered full and tickets will no longer be available. If you have any challenges, or need us to help you in getting your tickets ordered, please contact our office.

## Getting your tickets

On Monday, December 4<sup>th</sup>, ticket sales will stop so that we can tally our tickets and get them ready to physically send home to you in your child's planner. Any Tickets you booked should be going home with your child on Tuesday, December 5<sup>th</sup>.
